- Ali started the meeting by welcoming the participants.

- **Requirements analysis**
  - UEM has collected 17 questionnaires filled, until today.
  - UniZambeze has collected 24 questionnaires filled, until today.
  - UniLurio has collected 10 questionnaires filled, until today.
  - ACM: It was decided that ACM make requirement analysis from a national perspective with detailed discussion with national disaster management board. They have adopted the questionnaire.

  - A core module, one week, will be designed to be used in all courses. The core module includes introduction to GIS and RS.
  - QGIS will be used as the GIS software for the development of the courses.

    - Yifang and Maria will send a piece of code on Google Earth Engine to be run by Mozambican partners. The aim is to check if Google Earth Engine can be used as a tool for RS assignments. **Deadline to decided, April 7, 2020**.
