**Name of the course:**

Public Participatory GIS and Spatial Data Infrastructure in Disaster Management

**Progress of the core modules in percentage:**

With respect to the core week, regarding the material that is to be prepared by Politecnico di Milano:  
50% of the hours to be covered has been completed for the exercises;  
18% of the hours to be covered has been completed for the lectures.

**Progress of the course development (total) in percentage:**

We are focusing on lectures and exercises, which require the larger effort with respect to the preparation.

With respect to the lectures, 34% of the material is ready (excluding the core week).

With respect to the exercises, 20% of the material is ready (excluding the core week).

Most of this material corresponds to lectures and lecture notes which are about to be completed, so, in the next days, this percentage will increase, in view of the target for having 30% of the course ready by the end of September.
